



# BLACK EYECARE PERSPECTIVE PRE-OPTOMETRY CLUB (BEPPOC)

Black EyeCare Perspective Pre-Optometry Club (BEPPOC) is the first nationally recognized pre-optometry club by the Association of Schools and Colleges of Optometry (ASCO) and was established in 2020 to ensure not a single, potential Black or African American student or optometrist is ignored, discouraged or disadvantaged. BEPPOC provides future optometrist personal, professional & psychological resources and support they need to not only survive, but thrive in their pursuit of the profession.

BEPPOC had a 135% increase in membership from 2020 to 2021. The club has a membership of 94 Black future optometrists. Members consist of a majority of first or second generation students or college graduates from all over the nation and representing 24 states, 54 unique undergraduate institutions, 17 being Historically Black Colleges or Universities (HBCUs).

## ANALYSIS OF ASCO'S 2020-2021 ANNUAL STUDENT DATA REPORT

According to the Association of Schools and Colleges of Optometry (ASCO) annual report, 3.4% of full time Doctor of Optometry students identify as Black or African American. Of 7,339 students enrolled in an optometry program in the United States, only 253 are Black or African American.

The 2020 first year class has 79 of 1,946 students that identify as Black or African American (4.1%), a number that has increased and remained stable since the last academic year. Currently, there is one college of optometry without any Black or African American students enrolled, 12 of the 23 schools and colleges of optometry have 10 or more students enrolled and 3 colleges of optometry did not have any students that identify as Black or African American in their first year class.


